

# ERRATUM

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In the first paragraph of the Results section in Rush AJ et al “The 16-Item Quick Inventory of Depressive Symptomatology (QIDS), Clinician Rating (QIDS-C), and Self-Report (QIDS-SR): A Psychometric Evaluation in Patients with Chronic Major Depression” *Biological Psychiatry* 54:573–583 (this issue), Cronbach’s  $\alpha$  for the QIDS-SR<sub>16</sub> and IDS-SR<sub>16</sub> have been reversed. The sentence should read: “As expected, Cronbach’s  $\alpha$  increased consistently over time in this study for all four scales: QIDS-SR<sub>16</sub> = .57–.85 (baseline to week 12); IDS-SR<sub>30</sub> = .73–.92 (baseline to week 12); . . .” Also, the term “IDS-C<sub>30</sub>”

appears incorrectly twice, as well psychomotor “slowing,” in the second and third sentences of the fourth paragraph within the Results section. The sentences should read: “Mood variation (.30) and gastrointestinal complaints (.33) were poorly correlated with the total IDS-SR<sub>30</sub> score.
