

## Erratum

In the April 2007 issue of *Pediatric Clinics of North America* (Volume 54, Issue 2), an error appears in the article “Protecting Children from Toxic Exposure: Three Strategies” by Tee L. Guidotti and Lisa Ragain. The word “high” should be substituted for the word “low” on page 231, third full paragraph, sentence two. The sentence should read, “Most experts, however, now believe that this level of concern is too high because evidence for neurodevelopmental effects, in the form of group differences in IQ and academic achievement and a higher probability of behavioral abnormalities (including aggression), have been demonstrated even below this level [20–24].”
