

## Chest X-ray quiz

### Answer and discussion

This patient has collapse of the right upper lobe, as evidenced by marked elevation of the horizontal fissure (arrowed) with increased opacity in the right lung apex. There is no deviation of the trachea or mediastinum. The rest of the lungs and pleural spaces are clear. Yes you would be happy with the location of the right sided central line which has its tip over the region of the cavo-atrial junction.
