UMass Memorial Medical Center (UMMC) and the University of Massachusetts Medical School (UMMS) are seeking a dynamic leader for the position of Chairman, Department of Radiology/Physician Chief, Radiology Service Line. The new Chair will also serve as the system-wide Director of Imaging for UMass Memorial Health Care (UMMHC). UMMC is home to one of the top five departments of Radiology in the Northeast providing services at three campus sites and three satellite sites while pursuing cutting edge medical imaging research in a number of areas. The department is comprised of 37 radiologists and 19 basic science faculty offering an array of specialties including a world class Neurointerventional Radiology division as well as a pre-eminent Nuclear Medicine program. In addition to a residency in radiology, fellowships are offered in MR, Neuroradiology, Abdominal Imaging, Vascular Interventional Radiology, and Interventional Neuroradiology. The Chair will serve as Director of Imaging for UMMHC, responsible for creating and implementing a system-wide strategy for imaging. The successful candidate will be a highly accomplished board certified Radiologist who is academically recognized with demonstrated success as a chair, director or division chief and a track record of building programs, divisions or departments in a complex academic center. Ideally, candidates will have demonstrable accomplishments in teaching, publications and research to qualify as a full Professor at the University of Massachusetts Medical School.
